

Herefordshire Fencing Club: Photograph and Video Consent Forms and Policy

Herefordshire Fencing Club is committed to providing a safe environment for adults, children and young people, especially wherever and whenever photographs and/or videos are taken and stored.

HFC Photographic and Video Guidelines:

- Paramount to HFC policy are the interests and welfare of the fencers.
- You (parents/carers if under the age of 18) have the right to decide whether images/videos are to be taken and how those images may be used.
- For photos/videos to be taken there must be written consent for the fencers in the images. However it should be accepted that children may appear in the background of general pictures and that it may not be practical or reasonable to seek consent in all circumstances.
- Care should be taken to ensure that images/videos are not sexual or exploitative in nature.
- Image recording will only take place under the direct supervision of the members of the Club Committee.
